On many levels, 2019 was an interesting year at your Trails Racquet Club. With no major natural disasters to deal with, the main focus was on further improving the quality of the courts. As surrounding facilities struggle with that issue, your Trails Racquet Club was lucky to have 2 hardworking maintenance experts, courtmeister Gary and Mike The Frisbee Dog, to take care of the courts and the landscape. The courts improved throughout the year. That sentiment was validated when the Trails was selected to host two large USTA junior tournaments in the fourth quarter. And another one will take place in mid January 2020.

Both adult and junior membership increased slightly in 2019, which is welcome. It more than offset the sad passing of 3 long time members: Jim Cassidy, Phyllis Pain, and Linda Mallory, all in the first half of the year. With membership increasing and the courts being in fine shape, attention will turn to two areas: 1. the updating of the clubhouse, albeit at the usual glacial pace.
